



Here are a few local Vancouver activities that CLINICCAI participants are invited to attend. We hope that participating in these events will offer you an opportunity to see Vancouver, meet the local Vancouver medical community, learn something new and deepen your friendship with the other CLINICCAI participants.

1) October 10th at 6:55am. CLINICCAI sunrise seawall run.

Start the day right by meeting Philip Edgcumbe (Vancouver local, radiology resident, and member of the CLINICCAI organizing committee) and other CLINICCAI participants at the [Vancouver Convention Center Olympic Cauldron](#) at 6:55 a.m. on October 10th. We will go for a 5km run along the Coal Harbour Seawall at a pace of about 5:15 minute/km. You'll be back at the Olympic Cauldron and Convention Center by 7:25 am (sunrise at 7:26am!).

2) October 11th at 7am. Meet the Vancouver surgical community by attending the UBC Department of Surgery Grand Rounds and touring the new Vancouver General Hospital (VGH) operating rooms.

The grand rounds talk title is "AI and Augmented Reality (AR) in Surgery – Report from the front lines" and the presenters will be three CLINICCAI participants (Drs. [Philip Pratt](#), [Pieter De Backer](#), and [Philip Edgcumbe](#)) and VGH Plastic Surgeon, [Dr. Kathryn Isaac](#) (Full talk details [here](#)). The grand round presentation will go from 7am-8am on Wednesday, October 11th at VGH in the [Paetzold Health Education Centre](#) at [VGH at 899 West 12th Avenue](#). Following the talk, there will be an opportunity to mix and mingle with the VGH surgeons, demo some AR goggles, and do a tour of the [new VGH ORs](#). [Dr. Gary Redekep](#), a neurosurgeon and head of the UBC Department of Surgery, will lead the VGH OR tour.

3) Date and time TBD. Tour of the Saint Paul's Hospital (SPH) [MRI Core at the Centre for Heart Lung Innovation](#).

[Saint Paul's Hospital \(1081 Burrard Street\)](#) is a 20 minute walk from the Vancouver Convention Center. We can likely do a tour on October 11th or 12th. However, we will only offer this tour if we get interest from at least four CLINICCAI participants. And, we will set the time based on the availability/interest of participants.

4) October 12th at 9am. Bike ride around Stanley Park

Meet at [Bikes and Blades rental shop](#) at [710 Denman St](#). We will rent bikes (\$20) and bike around Stanley Park (about 90 minutes) on the seawall. This is an iconic Vancouver bike ride. This event is weather-dependent.
