

Dear MICCAI Reviewers:

We are now ready to begin the review process. We have attempted to distribute the papers fairly, taking into account your bid, your expertise, domain conflicts, and similarity with the papers you uploaded to TPMS. We aimed to assign no more than 5 papers per reviewers. If you received less than 5 assignments, we may add additional papers in the coming days when we reshuffle mismatched papers.

Please, as soon as possible and **no later than April 8th**, check for any issues in your paper. In rare cases where you feel unable to review one of your assigned papers, you can request for reassignment and we will get a replacement paper assigned to you on or before April 10 (see page 3 on how to request reassignment). Please do not ask to reassign a paper you have previously bid willing or eager to review. Note that the reassignment may not result in a better-matched paper for you to review.

After April 9th, all reassignment requests must be submitted to the meta-reviewer (area chair) of the paper (via the email Meta-reviewer button in CMT).
