no, this is not allowed. you need to make judgment on what's provided. keep in mind miccai presentation does not need to be the final version of the effort.

I know we are not suppose to ask for additional experiments, but what if the paper is severely lacking the experiment, such as no ablation study or no competing methods? Can we point this out as a weakness in the review?

yes, that could be basis for lack of rigor and you can rate the paper accordingly. Always explain your decision.

If sharing code in a rebuttal - do I have to anonymize my repo (pain in the butt and I don't like having my work shared without my name attached) or can I just share the repo attached to my own github account?

it has to be anonymized

Could you indicate how we should consider grammar/spelling errors that don't really affect the content?
